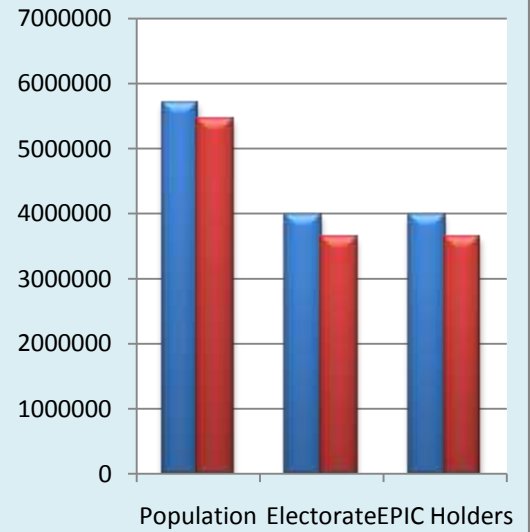

Composition of Population, Electors and EPIC holders

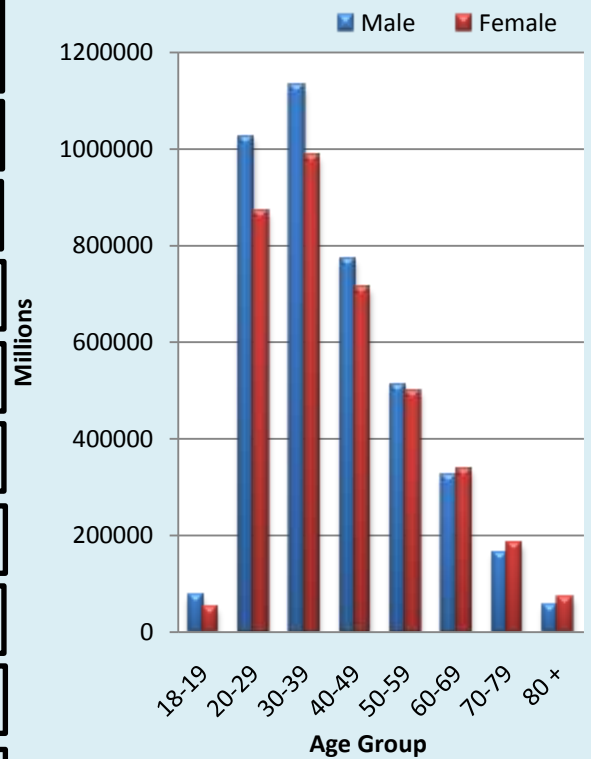
