
Sub: Clarification on 'None of the above'-counting of votes-reg.

Sir,

A question has been raised whether the votes polled against the NOTA option is to be considered for determining the forfeiture of security deposit.

The votes polled against the NOTA option cannot be treated as valid votes. Under Section 158 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951, it is the total number of valid votes polled by all the contesting candidates that is to be taken into account for calculating the one-sixth of votes polled by individual candidates for return of security deposit. Thus, it is clarified that the votes polled against the NOTA option is not to be taken into account for calculating the total valid votes polled by the contesting candidates for the purpose of return of security deposit.

A doubt has been raised about applicability of "NOTA" option during elections to Rajya Sabha in the light of the Hon'ble Supreme Court judgment dated 27.09.2013 in W.P (C) No. 161 of 2004 (PUCL & Anr. Vs UOI & Anr.). The Commission has duly considered the matter and it has been decided that the NOTA option will also be applicable for elections to Rajya Sabha. Accordingly, the Commission hereby directs that after the name and particulars of the last candidate on the ballot paper another panel may be provided and the words "None of the above (NOTA)" shall be printed therein in the language or languages in which the ballot paper is printed as per the direction issued by the Commission in pursuance of Sub-Rule (1) of Rule 22 and Sub-Rule (1) of Rule 30, read with Rule 70 of the Conduct of Election Rules 1961.

2. Please bring the above instructions to the notice of the Returning Officers for Conduct of Elections to the Council of States for compliance during the current biennial elections to Rajya Sabha already announced to fill up the vacancies to be caused in the month of April 2014 and all future elections to Rajya Sabha.

3. Necessary instructions with regard to marking of ballot paper for exercising the option of "None of the Above" and the counting of votes in view of the above option will be issued shortly.

4. Please acknowledge the receipt of this letter and confirm action taken as required above.


Kindly refer to the Commission's letter of even no. dated 24.01.2014 regarding applicability of the option of "NOTA" for elections to Rajya Sabha and about issue of necessary instructions with regard marking of ballot paper for exercising the option of NOTA and counting of votes separately.

The procedure for method of voting is provided under Rule 37A of CE Rules 1961, as made applicable under rule 70. In the case of an elector deciding to exercise the option of NOTA, s/he shall indicate so in the space provided by either putting a cross mark (X) or a tick mark (✓). A ballot paper on which NOTA option has been marked with a cross or tick mark would be treated as invalid even if it contains any preference/ figure against the name of a candidate. The presumption would be that a voter who has exercised NOTA option on a ballot paper has exercised the option in respect of all candidates.

Since NOTA is an option for not giving preference to any of the candidates in fray and as such this is not to be taken into account while ascertaining the quota under Rule 75 or 76 of CE Rules 1961.

The above instructions may be brought to the notice of all the ROs for compliance.


Subject: Provision for "None of the above" option on ballot paper for elections to State Legislative Council-regarding.

Sir,

Kindly refer to the Commission's letter of even no. dated 27 Feb, 2014 on the above subject. A clarification has been sought as to the validity status of a ballot paper on which an elector deciding to exercise the option of NOTA puts some preference number instead of cross mark (X) or tick mark (✓) as prescribed by the Commission.

It is hereby clarified that any marking against the NOTA option on the ballot paper other than the ones prescribed by the Commission, would also invalidate the ballot paper. Therefore, it is necessary to give adequate publicity / awareness to the type of markings i.e. cross mark (X) or tick mark (✓) that can be put against the option of NOTA on the ballot paper by an elector wishing to exercise that option. For this purpose a small pamphlet can be printed and displayed outside each polling station for the information of the electors. This can also be given wide publicity before the poll day by issue of an advertisement in the newspapers and also informing the contesting candidates in writing.

Sir,

In pursuance of the Hon'ble Supreme Court's judgment dated 27-09-2013 in W.P. (C) No. 161 of 2004 (PUCL & Anr. Vs UoI & Anr), the Commission has already issued instructions to provide for NOTA option in elections for Lok Sabha and Legislative Assembly. Later the Commission issued separate direction that "NOTA" option will also be applicable in the elections to Rajya Sabha and State Legislative Councils. Necessary instructions for applicability of "NOTA" option during elections to Rajya Sabha has been issued vide letter no. 576/3/2013/SDR dated 24-01-2014.

The Commission hereby directs that, at the elections to State Legislative Council also, after the name and particulars of the last candidate on the ballot paper, another panel shall be provided and the words "None of the above (NOTA)" shall be printed therein in the language or languages in which the ballot paper is printed as per the direction issued by the Commission in pursuance of Sub-Rule (1) of Rule 22 and Sub-Rule (1) of Rule 30 read with Rule 70 of the Conduct of Elections Rules, 1961.

The procedure for method of voting is provided under Rule 37A of the Conduct of Elections Rules, 1961, as made applicable under rule 70. In the case of an elector deciding to exercise the option of NOTA, s/he shall indicate so in the space provided by either putting a cross mark (X) or a tick mark (✓). A ballot paper on which NOTA option has been marked with a cross or tick mark would be treated as invalid even if it contains any preference/figure against the name of a candidate. The presumption would be that a voter who has exercised NOTA option on a ballot paper has exercised the option in respect of all candidates.



**Sub : Manner of opting for 'None of the Above' at elections to Rajya Sabha and State
Legislative Council- revised instructions of the Commission.**

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to invite reference to the Commission's two circular letters, both bearing No. 576/3/2013/SDR-Vol.II, dated 24th January, 2014 and 27th February, 2014, regarding provision for NOTA and the manner of marking for NOTA option at elections to Rajya Sabha and State Legislative Councils. As per the instructions therein, option for NOTA was to be marked with a cross or tick mark against 'None of the Above' panel on the ballot paper.

2. It has been brought to the notice of the Commission that there have been some cases where electors, having marked 1st preference against one of the candidates put cross mark or mentioned subsequent preference (2nd, 3rd, etc.) against NOTA, which have led to rejection of the ballot paper. In the light of such cases, the Commission has considered the matter afresh and, with a view to ensuring the compliance of rule 73(2) of the CE Rules 1961 and adoption of a uniform approach towards the requirement of providing for NOTA option and the manner of voting in preferential system using single transferable vote, the Commission has given the following directions for exercising of NOTA option in elections to Rajya Sabha and State Legislative Councils:-

(i) Marking against NOTA shall be by way of writing figures 1, 2, 3, etc. as in the case of marking preference for candidates, i.e in international form of Indian numerals or in the Roman form or in any Indian language ;

(ii) If preference '1' is marked against NOTA, it shall be treated as a case of not voting for any of the candidates and such ballot shall be treated as invalid, even if '1' is also marked against any other candidate in addition to being marked against NOTA;


(iii) If 1st preference is validly marked against one of the candidates, and 2nd preference is marked against NOTA, such ballot paper shall be treated as valid for the candidate for whom 1st preference has been marked, provided there is no other ground to invalidate it, under rule 73(2). In such case, at the stage of examining 2nd preference, the ballot paper shall be treated as exhausted as the 2nd preference is marked against NOTA. Similarly, if 1st and 2nd preferences are validly marked against a candidate each and 3rd preference is marked against NOTA, the ballot shall be valid for the first count and for the purposes of the 2nd preference, but, at the stage of examining the 3rd preference, if such stage comes, the ballot shall be treated as exhausted. These instructions shall apply for subsequent preferences also.

(iv) If 1st preference and subsequent preferences, if any, are validly marked against the candidates and cross/tick is marked against NOTA, the ballot paper shall not be rejected as invalid only on this ground, and the preferences marked against the candidates shall be considered and counted accordingly. However, the general provisions of the rules and the Commission's instructions regarding marks that may identify the voter shall apply in the case of the mark against NOTA option, and if the RO considers that the mark put therein reasonably points towards identification of the voter within the meaning of rule 73(2)(d), that would render the ballot liable to rejection on that ground.

3. Some sample markings on the ballot in accordance with the above directions are attached herewith for more clarity.

4. These directions may be brought to the notice of Returning Officers for Rajya Sabha elections in the State, and for all elections to the Legislative Council (in the States having such council) for compliance in all future elections. The political parties based in the State/UT may also be informed about these directions.
