2. Now, the Commission has decided to conduct biennial elections to the Council of States from above mentioned States in accordance with the following programme:

2.	Last date of making nominations	31 st May, 2022 (Tuesday)
3.	Scrutiny of nominations	01 st June, 2022 (Wednesday)
4.	Last date for withdrawal of candidatures	03 rd June, 2022 (Friday)
5.	Date of Poll	10th June, 2022 (Friday)
6.	Hours of Poll	09:00 am- 04:00 pm
7.	Counting of Votes	10 th June, 2022 (Friday) at 05:00 pm
8.	Date before which election shall be completed	13 th June, 2022 (Monday)

3. The Commission has directed that for the purpose of marking preference(s) on the ballot paper only integrated violet colour sketch pen(s) of pre-fixed specification, provided by the Returning Officer, shall be used. No other pen shall, under any circumstances, be used in the above said elections.
4. Adequate measures for close monitoring of the election process by appointing observers shall be taken to ensure free and fair election.

6. The Commission has also directed the Chief Secretaries concerned to depute a senior officer from the State to ensure that the extant instructions regarding COVID-19 containment measures are complied with while making arrangements for conduct of the elections.
