Sir,

I am directed to forward herewith Proceedings No. 318/CS-Multi/2/2022/BE, dated 12th May, 2022 (along with its Hindi version) of the Election Commission of India regarding issue of notifications by the President under Section 12 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951, calling upon the elected members of the Legislative Assemblies of 15 States to elect 57 members to fill the seats in the Council of States to be caused vacant due to the retirement of the sitting members. - 3. The Commission has directed that for the purpose of marking preference(s) on the ballot paper only integrated violet colour sketch pen(s) of pre-fixed specification, provided by the Returning Officer, shall be used. No other pen shall, under any circumstances, be used in the above said elections.
- 4. Adequate measures for close monitoring of the election process by appointing observers shall be taken to ensure free and fair election.
- 5. - 6. The Commission has also directed the Chief Secretaries concerned to depute a senior officer from the State to ensure that the extant instructions regarding COVID-19 containment measures are complied with while making arrangements for conduct of the elections.
