ECI has decided that the agency for production and supply of hologram will be shortlisted with CEO and the award of contract, execution of contract, issuance of procurement orders and sanction of payments will be managed by CEO office of the UTs.

This Bid document is therefore intended to invite bids from reputed and reliable companies/Firm for undertaking the work of manufacturing and supply of Hologram for hot stamping on EPIC cards.

It will be imperative for each Bidder(s) to familiarize itself/themselves with the prevailing legal situations for the executing of contract. This Department shall not entertain any request for clarification from the Bidder regarding such legal aspects of submission of the Bids.

It will be the responsibility of the Bidder that all factors have been investigated and considered while submitting the Bids, and no claim whatsoever including those of financial adjustments to the contract awarded under this tender will be entertained. 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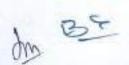

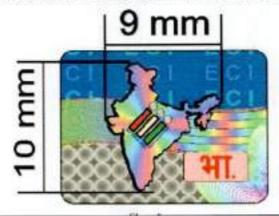
